THE IMPORTANCE OF GOD'S GLORY IN OUR WORSHIP

"...; I looked and saw the glory of the Lord filling the temple of the Lord, and I fell facedown." (Ezekiel 44:4b NIV)

April 2025 is the month of commemoration of Easter, namely the commemoration of the day of Christ's resurrection from death.
