## BUILD A SPIRIT THAT BUILDS UP EACH OTHER

"For God did not designate us to be wrathful, but to be saved through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, so that whether we watch or sleep, we may live with Him. Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, as you are doing" (1 Thess. 5:9-11)

Praise God, we have been led by God to enter the month of June 2022. It often happens that there are people who follow God by presenting themselves as if they seem spiritually mature, but in reality they are not. Many are supposed to be "spiritually mature" and able to build each other up. But when the ability to process problems feels deadlocked and insurmountable, they choose to distance themselves and leave the church, the place where they should be planted and pastored. Such people find it difficult to grow into spiritual maturity because they often treat others only as objects to fulfill their interests and not to build each other up. The root of the problem lies in a false spirituality, which is not rooted in the understanding and truth of His Word. The guiding verse of God's Word today says, "For God did not designate us to be afflicted with wrath, but to be saved through Jesus Christ our Lord, who died for us, so that whether we are awake or asleep, we may live together same with Him. Therefore, encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing" (1 Thess. 5:9-11). Therefore, let us be more serious in advising one another and building one another up, so that we can become His church that is increasingly pleasing to God. Amen!
